There are single-stall family restrooms, which welcome people of all genders, near every set of multi-stall bathrooms in the convention center.



Non-Denominational Prayer Room, Room 158

The prayer room is open whenever the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center is open.

Parking

The BCEC currently maintains 1,343 parking spaces in the South Parking Lot which is located at the rear of the facility. There are also 200 parking spaces that are utilized for valet parking. Both operations accept credit cards and cash. *Please keep in mind that there is no 24-hour parking, or overnight parking at the BCEC.* Attendees must pay upon entering the lot, there are no in and out privileges. Any vehicles left overnight will be towed at the owner's expense. Parking can be sponsored for attendees, please contact the Transportation Department for rates and availability.

Public Transportation and Access

The BCEC is **steps away from the MBTA's Silver Line World Trade Center stop, which is the same subway line that services Logan Airport**. It's also a 15-minute walk from South Station, one of Boston's major transportation hubs.

Sales Tax

The sales tax in Boston, MA is 6.25%; city hotel tax is 8.45% and an additional tax of up to 6% can be added to the hotel tax; and food and beverage tax is 6.25%.

Shuttle Bus Service

ASCB does not provide shuttle service for this meeting.

Tipping

Tipping is standard in the United States. Here are a few tipping guidelines: restaurant/bar wait staff, 15- 20+%; taxi drivers, 15%; doormen, skycaps, and porters, \$2 per bag; hotel housekeeping, \$2-\$3 per room, per night.

What to Wear

Wear comfortable shoes—you'll be doing a lot of walking. Most attendees dress in jeans and casual wear. Dress in layers or bring a jacket or sweater because it is difficult to control temperature in the convention center and it can get either too warm or too cold in some rooms in the convention center throughout the meeting.
